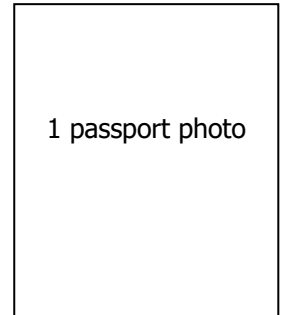
Tuition fee per academic year (all-inclusive package) **CHF 8'640.00**

To be paid in advance of each month = 9 times CHF 960.00 / Yearly payment in advance = CHF 8'473.00

**The „all-inclusive package“ includes** (5 years at CHF 8`640.00 each): all mandatory courses (including paediatrics), course material, clinical days, examinations fees. Support for the proposal and thesis to get the title Osteopath D.O. (followed after the 5 years). During the 5 years of study, courses can be repeated free of charge; a daily contribution to expenses of CHF 38.00 is charged.

Additional costs:

Accommodation: Single room, incl. breakfast & dinner: CHF 75.50 – CHF 95.50 / Double room, incl. breakfast & dinner: CHF 59.00 – CHF 75.50 / Additional annual fee for a special diet CHF 50.00 / Additional books: about CHF 200.00 per academic year / Not mandatory courses / Costs for additional anatomy courses, if needed.



## General Conditions

### Application

- Upon receipt of the application, the registration fee becomes due. The application is binding; acceptance to the programme is decided by the school management. You will receive a confirmation of registration along with an invoice for the registration fee.
- Should the programme or course already be fully booked, you will be informed immediately.

### Registration and material fee

- The registration fee for the programme is due with the acceptance of the application and is not refundable.

### Course leave notice

- There are two termination dates per academic year: **15 February** and **30 June**  
The notice of termination must be received by SICO on 15 February or 30 June at the latest.
- If cancelled by 15 February, half of the tuition fee is due. If cancelled by 30 June, the tuition fee for the entire year is due.
- Unattended courses are not refundable.

### Suspension notice

- If a course cannot be attended or the course needs to be postponed, it must be communicated in writing at least one month in advance by mail or email.

### Venue

- Unless otherwise stated, all courses are held on the SICO Campus at Zinnenstrasse 7, 6353 Hertenstein.

### Miscellaneous

- The course material (scripts, worksheets, etc.) is included in the course fee.
- The books recommended by the lecturers are not included.

### Insurance

- The use of the SICO facilities and the Stella Matutina Educational Centre is at your own risk. Therefore, SICO declines all liability for damages, theft and loss of objects.
- Students at SICO have to conclude a professional liability insurance for working with patients.

### Terms of payment

- When paying tuition fees, you can choose between monthly and annual rates.  
The nine monthly instalments per academic year are due on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 1<sup>st</sup> October, 1<sup>st</sup> November, 1<sup>st</sup> December, 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1<sup>st</sup> February, 1<sup>st</sup> March, 1<sup>st</sup> April und 1<sup>st</sup> May.  
The annual instalment is due 1<sup>st</sup> September.
- The registration and material fee is due within 10 days after the school administration has confirmed acceptance to the programme. Otherwise, the place is not secured.
